
The Starr Family Home tells the story of the Starr family and their important role in the settlement of Texas after the Civil War. The centerpiece of the site, Maplecroft mansion, is furnished with family furniture, portraits, and clothing from 1870-1900 that illuminate the life and times of the Starr family. The site is beautifully landscaped with vibrant azaleas, camellias, and roses, and is located near downtown Marshall, Texas.
