MAGOFFIN HOME

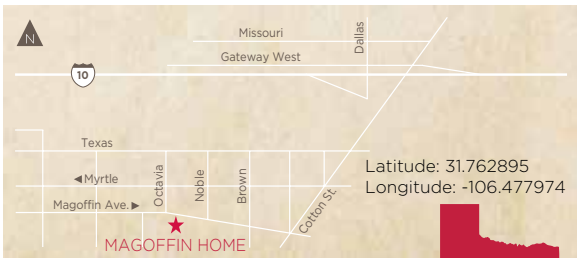
Within this adobe structure, the property explores the stories of a multicultural family. The Magoffins participated in American expansion, West Texas settlement, trade on the Santa Fe Trail, Civil War turmoil, military service, and U.S.-Mexico relations. The home, built around 1875 by Joseph Magoffin, is an example of Territorial style architecture and features a peaceful landscape.
